Sub : Submission of Schemes under BADP for the year 2008-09.

Sir,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that the State Government has decided to draw up schemes for an amount of Rs.5,77,20,000.00 (Rupees five crore seventy seven lakhs twenty thousand) only *being 10% of the State's total allocation under BADP during 2008-09* for **security related activities** and allocated an amount of Rs.1,44,30,000.00/- (Rupees one crore forty four lakhs thirty thousand) only to the Indo Tibet Border Police, Khating Hill, Itanagar for taking up schemes under BADP during 2008-09. Out of which schemes worth Rs.27,75,000/- (Rupees twenty seven lakhs seventy five thousand) only have already been approved in the 19th SLSC meeting during 2007-08. Hence, you are, therefore requested to draw up schemes worth Rs.1,16,55,000.00/- (Rupees one crore sixteen lakhs fifty five thousand) only and to submit the same to the Planning Department latest by 8th August, 2008 for approval of the State Level Screening Committee and forward the same to the MHA for their approval and release of fund.

2. Further, the schemes are to be selected strictly in accordance with the **revised guidelines 2008** of BADP and as per the illustrative list of schemes / projects mentioned at 'Annexure-III' in the revised guidelines. The proposals should be submitted as per the new prescribed format given at 'Annexure-V' in the revised guidelines issued by the MHA for the purpose. A copy of the revised guidelines and Annexure-III, V, V(a), V(b) and VI are enclosed herewith for your information and necessary action.

3. As decided by the State Government, after approval of the schemes by the MHA and receipt of fund from GOI, the fund for implementation of security related schemes will be sub-allocated to the concerned Deputy Commissioners against the respective schemes and the concerned security agencies will be submit detail bills against the completed work to the respective DCs for making payment. The fund under BADP is lapsable and will have to be utilized within the current financial year.

4. Decision regarding utilization of 1% fund allocation (subject to maximum Rs.25.00 lakhs) as mentioned at para-6.4 in the page-5 of the revised guidelines will be taken in due course.

5. While submitting the schemes following points may be taken into account :-

- a) Schemes should be designed to take care of the special problems faced in the border blocks, particularly in the rural areas. Schemes for rural and remote areas along the international border should be given preference over schemes for other areas.
- b) The schemes proposed, should be strictly as per eligibility appended in the illustrative list of schemes (Annexure-III) admissible under the revised guidelines of BADP-2008.
- c) Individual schemes with detail specifications are only to be proposed.
- d) The schemes which will be proposed under BADP should not be taken-up from any other Central / State funded programmes including DLP, MLALADs, MPLADs, CSS and normal state plans. In this regard, a certificate separately along with the list of schemes should submit, without which proposals will not be considered for placing before the SLSC.
- e) The proposals received after the stipulated date / not covered under BADP guidelines / without relevant information and detail specification / not submitted in the prescribed format will be summarily rejected.
- f) Schemes should be proposed after proper scrutiny, since change of scheme(s), once proposed, will not be entertained.
- g) The proposals may kindly be submitted both in hard and soft copy.
